Finished Product: the finished doll is approx. 8-8.5" tall. (Depending on your tension and the yarn you use, it might end up being a little bit taller or a little bit shorter)

Materials:

- Yarn: Light orange, red, green and purple . I used two strands of 100% acrylic knitting yarn (4ply). Size around 2mm per photo attached.



Anyhow, the pattern can be made using any yarn you wish. Adjust your hook size so that your stitches are as tight as possible.

- G hook no. 7/0 (Tulip brand)
- Polyester fiberfill for stuffing (your choice)
- 5mm black beads or safety eyes (optional)
- Stitch marker
- Sewing pin
- Small amount of pink embroidery thread for embroider mouth.

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet (UK: dc double crochet)
trc = Treble crochet

inc = increase (2sc in a stitch)
dec = decrease (2sc off together)

hdc = half double crochet
sl st = slip st (UK: sc single crochet)
ch = chain
rep = repeat(s)(ing)

dc = double crochet
R = round

st(s) = stitch(es)

1. HEAD Using light orange

- R1:** Make a loop with 6sc
R2: inc6 (12sts)
R3: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R4: *sc2, inc1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R5: *sc3, inc1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R6: *sc4, inc1* repeat 6 times (36sts)
R7: *sc5, inc1* repeat 6 times (42sts)
R8-11: sc42 (42sts)
R12: *sc5, dec1* repeat 6 times (36sts)
R13: *sc4, dec1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R14: *sc3, dec1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R15: *sc2, dec1* repeat 6 times (18sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

2. ARMS Make 2 pieces /using light orange

start with light blue

- R1:** Make a loop with 6sc
R2: *sc1, inc1* repeat 3 times (9sts)
R3: *sc2, work 3-dc puff, sc6 (9sts)

3-dc puff(3 dc to be a puff)



- R4-8:** sc9 (9sts)
R9-11: switch to light orange, sc9 (9sts)
R12: sc1, dec1 * repeat 3 times * (6sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

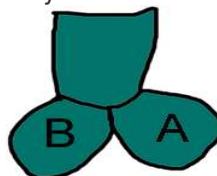
3. BODY AND TAIL Using green and light orange/ Make 2pcs of tail. (A&B)

We will crochet one tail first. Then do again (repeat R1-R9) for second tail. Do not fasten off the second tail. We will join them to make body (start from R10).

Start with green

- R1:** Make a loop with 4sc
R2: inc4 (8sts)
R3: sc8 (8sts)
R4: inc8 (16sts)
R5-6: sc16 (16sts)
R7: dec8 (8sts)
R9: sc8 (8sts)

Body start R10 on A



- R10:** sc4 (A), sc8 (B), sc4 (A) (16sts)
R11: *sc2, dec1* repeat 4 times (12sts)
R12: sc12 (12sts)
R13: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R14-18: sc18 (18sts)
R19: *sc2, inc1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R20-21: sc24 (12sts)
R22: *sc3, inc1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R23-24: sc30 (30sts)
R25-28: switch to light orange, sc30 (30sts)
R29: *sc3, dec1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R30: *sc2, dec1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R31: sc18 (18sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

4. **BRASSERIE** Make 2 pieces /Using purple

A:

R1: Make a loop with 4sc

R2: sc4 (4sts)

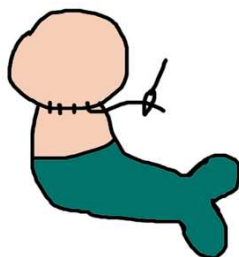
R3: inc4 (8sts)

R4: sc8 (8sts)

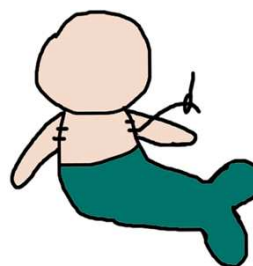
Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

ASSEMBLY

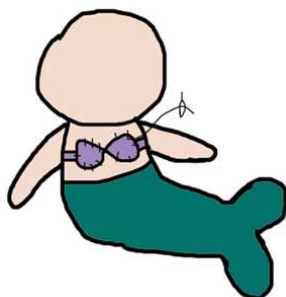
1. Stuff with polyester then sew head to body.



2. Stuff with polyester then sew arms to body.



3. Sew brasserie on body and embroidery white yarn on brasserie.



4. Use red yarn to making hair by cut the yarn around 12inches long. Sew on center of head back to end of head. Brush her hair with comb till the hair fluff up.



5. Sew 5mm black bead as an eye, embroidery pink thread as mouth, brush a small amount of pink or red blusher on cheeks.



Safety Notice

Buttons and small parts can be a hazard to small children. To be safe, all animals intended for use as toys should have embroidered eyes.
