

Pattern No.93 : **Princess Jasmine**
Designed : **Sea and lighthouse**

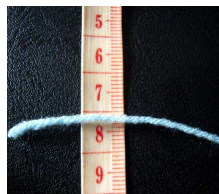
This pattern was designed and made by Sea and lighthouse. If you buy the pattern, please do not sell ANY copies of it VIA EMAIL OR PRINTED or in any other form. I am not selling the right to copy and sell the pattern. Use the pattern to make the finished doll. You can sell the dolls you make from the pattern, but not copies of the pattern. Thanks.

Finished Product: The finished doll is approx. 8-8.5" tall.

(Depending on your tension and the yarn you use, it might end up being a little bit taller or a little bit shorter)

Materials:

- Yarn: light brown, green, black, light green, blue and yellow. I used two strands of 100% acrylic knitting yarn (4ply). Size around 2mm per photo attached.



Anyway, the pattern can be made using any yarn you wish. Adjust your hook size so that your stitches are as tight as possible.

- G hook no. 7/0 (Tulip brand)
- Polyester fiberfill for stuffing (your choice)
- 5mm black beads or safety eyes (optional)
- Stitch marker
- Sewing pin
- Small amount of pink embroidery thread for embroider mouth.

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet (UK: dc double crochet)
 sl st = slip st (UK: sc single crochet)
 inc = increase (2sc in a stitch)
 dec = decrease (2sc off together)
 dc = double crochet
 R = round
 rep = repeat(s)(ing)
 st(s) = stitch(es)
 ch = chain

1. HEAD Using light brown

R1: Make a loop with 6sc
R2: inc6 (12sts)
R3: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R4: *sc2, inc1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R5: *sc3, inc1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R6: *sc4, inc1* repeat 6 times (36sts)
R7: *sc5, inc1* repeat 6 times (42sts)
R8-12: sc42 (42sts)
R13: *sc5, dec1* repeat 6 times (36sts)
R14: *sc4, dec1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R15: *sc3, dec1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R16: *sc2, dec1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R17: sc18 (18sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

3. ARMS Make 2 pieces /using light brown

R1: Make a loop with 6sc
R2: *sc1, inc1 * repeat 2 times (9sts)
R3: *sc2, work 3-dc puff, sc6 (9sts)

3-dc puff(3 dc to be a puff)



R4-12: sc9 (9sts)
R13: *sc1, dec1* repeat 3 times (6sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

2. BODY Using green light green and light brown

start with green
R1: Make a loop with 6sc
R2: inc6 (12sts)
R3: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R4: *sc2, inc1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R5: *sc3, inc1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R6: sc30 (30sts)
R7: **switch to light green**, sc30 (30sts)
R8-11: **switch to light brown**, sc30 (30sts)
R12: **switch to green**, sc30 (30sts)
R13: *sc3, dec1*repeat 6 times (24sts)
R14: **switch to light brown**, *sc2, dec1*repeat 6 times (18sts)
R15: sc18 (18sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

4. SLEEVE make 2 pieces/ using green

R1: ch12
R2: ch1, sc12 (12sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

5. EARING make 2 pieces/ using yellow

R1: Make a loop with 4sc
R2: sc4 (4sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

6. LEGS Make 2 pieces /using green light green and light brown

A: start with green

R1: Make a loop with 6sc

R2: inc6 (12sts)

R3: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)

R4-5: sc 18 (18sts)

R6: **switch to light brown**, sc5, dec4, sc5 (14sts)

R7: sc5, dec2, sc5 (12sts)

R8: sc 12 (12sts)

R9: **switch to green**, sc 12 (12sts)

R10: inc12 (24sts)

R11-12: sc24 (24sts)

R13: *sc2, dec1* repeat 6 times (18sts)

R14: sc18 (18sts)

R15: dec9 (9sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

B: Make 2 pieces /using green

R1: Make a loop with 4sc

R2: sc4 (4sts)

R3: inc4 (8sts)

R4: sc8 (8sts)

R5: *sc1, inc1* repeat 4 times (12sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

8. NECKLACE using yellow

R1: ch27

R2: ch1, sc12, 3sc off together, sc12 (25sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

9. HEAD BAND with bright green and blue

A: using light green

R1: ch36

R2: ch1, sc36 (36sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off

B: using blue

R1: Make a loop with 4sc

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

7. HAIR Using black

A:

R1: Make a loop with 6sc

R2: inc6 (12sts)

R3: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)

R4: *sc2, inc1* repeat 6 times (24sts)

R5: *sc3, inc1* repeat 6 times (30sts)

R6: *sc4, inc1* repeat 6 times (36sts)

R7: *sc5, inc1* repeat 6 times (42sts)

R8: *sc6, inc1* repeat 6 times (48sts)

R9-10: sc42 (42sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

B: make 2 pieces

R1: ch18

R2: ch1 (count as 1sc), sc16, sc3 in ch, (Work on opposite side of starting ch) sc16, inc1 in ch (38sts.)

R3: inc1, sc16, inc3, sc16, inc2 (44sts)

R4: sc44 (44sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

C: using black and light green

R1: Make a loop with 4sc

R2-3: sc4 (4sts)

R4: inc4 (8sts)

R5: *sc3, inc1* repeat 2 times (10sts)

R6-7: sc10 (10sts)

R8: inc10 (20sts)

R9-12: sc20 (20sts)

R13: **switch to light green**, dec10 (10sts)

R14: sc20 (20sts)

R15: **switch to light brown**, *sc4, inc1* repeat 4 times (24sts)

R16-17: sc24 (24sts)

R18: *sc4, dec1* repeat 4 times (20sts)

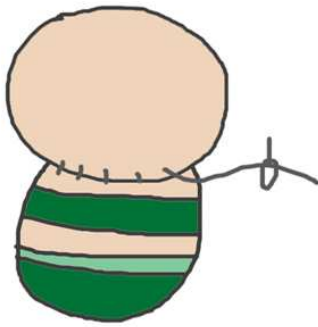
R19: **switch to light green**, dec10 (10sts)

R20: sc10 (10sts)

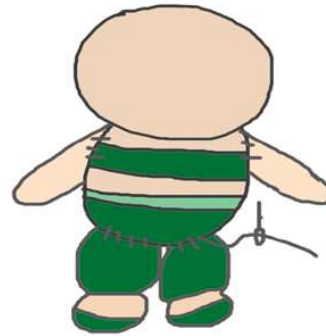
Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

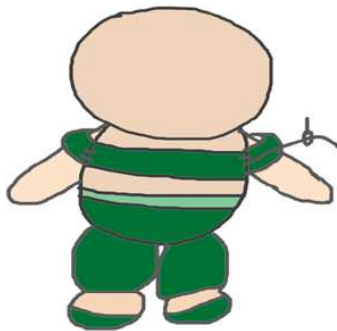
1. Stuff with polyester then sew head to body.



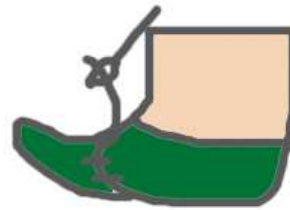
2. Stuff with polyester then sew legs and arms to body.



3. Sew sleeve to body.



4. Sew part B of legs to legs.



5. Sew part A of hair on head, sew B on front and sew C on back side.



6. Sew head band, earring and necklace. Sew 5mm black bead as an eye, embroidery pink thread as mouth, brush a small amount of pink or red blusher on cheeks.



Safety Notice

Buttons and small parts can be a hazard to small children. To be safe, all animals intended for use as toys should have embroidered eyes.
