

Pattern No.95 : Princess Ariel
Designed : Sea and lighthouse



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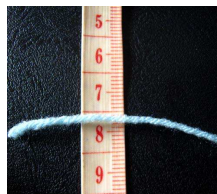
Please read:

This pattern was designed and made by Sea and lighthouse. If you buy the pattern, please do not sell ANY copies of it VIA EMAIL OR PRINTED or in any other form. I am not selling the right to copy and sell the pattern. Use the pattern to make the finished doll. You can sell the dolls you make from the pattern, but not copies of the pattern. Thanks.

Finished Product: the finished doll is approx. 8"-8.5" tall. (Depending on your tension and the yarn you use, it might end up being a little bit taller or a little bit shorter)

Materials:

- Yarn: light orange, pink, light pink, red and white. I used two strands of 100% acrylic knitting yarn (4ply). Size around 2mm per photo attached.



Anyhow, the pattern can be made using any yarn you wish. Adjust your hook size so that your stitches are as tight as possible.

- G hook no. 7/0 (Tulip brand)
- Polyester fiberfill for stuffing (your choice)
- 5mm black beads or safety eyes (optional)
- Stitch marker
- Sewing pin
- Small amount of pink embroidery thread for embroider mouth.

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet (UK: dc double crochet)
 sl st = slip st (UK: sc single crochet)
 inc = increase (2sc in a stitch)
 dec = decrease (2sc off together)

hdc = half double crochet
 rep = repeat(s)(ing)
 ch = chain

dc = double crochet
 R = round
 st(s) = stitch(es)

1. HEAD Using light orange

R1: Make a loop with 6sc
R2: inc6 (12sts)
R3: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R4: *sc2, inc1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R5: *sc3, inc1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R6: *sc4, inc1* repeat 6 times (36sts)
R7: *sc5, inc1* repeat 6 times (42sts)
R8-11: sc42 (42sts)
R12: *sc5, dec1* repeat 6 times (36sts)
R13: *sc4, dec1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R14: *sc3, dec1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R15: *sc2, dec1* repeat 6 times (18sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

3. LEGS Make 2 pieces /using light orange and pink

start with pink
R1: Make a loop with 6sc
R2: inc6 (12sts)
R3: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R4-5: sc 18 (18sts)
R6: **switch to light orange**, sc5, dec4, sc5 (14sts)
R7: sc5, dec2, sc5 (12sts)
R8-14: sc 12 (12sts)
R15: *sc4, dec1*repeat 2 times (10sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

2. BODY Using light orange, pink and white

start with light orange
R1: Make a loop with 6sc
R2: inc6 (12sts)
R3: *sc1, inc1* repeat 6 times (18sts)
R4: *sc2, inc1* repeat 6 times (24sts)
R5: *sc3, inc1* repeat 6 times (30sts)
R6-7: sc30 (30sts)
R8-11: **switch to pink**, sc30 (30sts)
R12: *sc3, dec1*repeat 6 times (24sts)
R13: **switch to light orange**, *sc2, dec1*repeat 6 times (18sts)
R14: sc18 (18sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

4. ARMS Make 2 pieces /using pink and light orange

start with light orange
R1: Make a loop with 6sc
R2: *sc1, inc1 * repeat 3 times (9sts)
R3: *sc2, work 3-dc puff, sc6 (9sts)

3-dc puff(3 dc to be a puff)



R4-8: **switch to pink**, sc9 (9sts)
R9: inc9 (18sts)
R10-11: sc18 (18sts)
R12: **switch to light orange** dec9 (9sts)
R13: sc9 (9sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

5. SKIRT Using pink and light pink

A: Note: change to light pink as indicated in blue letter

start with pink

R1: ch30, join

R2: ch1, sc30, join (30sts)

R4: ch1, inc30, join (60sts)

R5-6: ch1, sc60, join (60sts)

R7: *sc4, dec1*repeat 10 times, join (50sts)

R8: ch1, sc23, **sc4**, sc23, join (50sts)

R9: ch1, sc22, **sc6**, sc22, join (50sts)

R10: ch1, sc21, **sc8**, sc21, join (50sts)

R11: ch1, sc20, **sc10**, sc20, join (50sts)

R12: ch1, sc19, **sc12**, sc19, join (50sts)

R13-17: ch1, sc18, **sc14**, sc18, join (50sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

B: make 2 pieces/ using pink

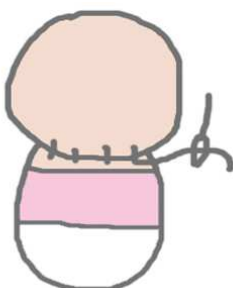
R1: ch15

R2: ch1, sc2, hdc2, dc7, hdc2, sc2

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

ASSEMBLY

1. Stuff with polyester then sew head to body.



2. Stuff with polyester then sew legs and arms to body.



3. Sew skirt (A) to body on R8 (count from bottom).



4. Sew skirt (B) on (A).



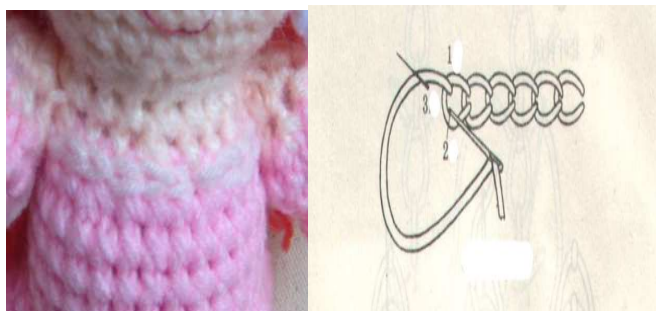
6. EARING make 2 pieces/ using white

R1: Make a loop with 3sc

R2: sc3 (3sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

5. Embroider light pink yarn as chain stitch on R12.



6. - Use red yarn to making hair by cut the yarn around 10inches long. Band 4 strands together by using the 5th strand to band all. Sew each bunch to head start on R3 back stitch to back part of head. Garter together the hair together.



7. Roll hair and sew beside.

8. Sew 5mm black bead as an eye, embroidery pink thread as mouth, brush a small amount of pink or red blusher on cheeks and sew earring on R12.



Safety Notice

Buttons and small parts can be a hazard to small children. To be safe, all animals intended for use as toys should have embroidered eyes.
