Sea and lighthouse



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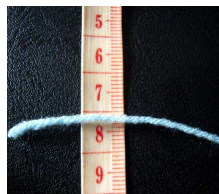
**Please read:**

This pattern was designed and made by Sea and lighthouse. If you buy the pattern, please do not sell ANY copies of it VIA EMAIL OR PRINTED or in any other form. I am not selling the right to copy and sell the pattern. Use the pattern to make the finished doll. You can sell the dolls you make from the pattern, but not copies of the pattern. Thanks.

**Finished Product:** the finished doll is approx. 8-8.5" tall. (Depending on your tension and the yarn you use, it might end up being a little bit taller or a little bit shorter)

**Materials:**

- Yarn: Light orange, yellow, pink, light pink, white and bright yellow . I used two strands of 100% acrylic knitting yarn (4ply). Size around 2mm per photo attached.



Anyway, the pattern can be made using any yarn you wish. Adjust your hook size so that your stitches are as tight as possible.

- G hook no. 7/0 (Tulip brand)
- Polyester fiberfill for stuffing (your choice)
- 5mm black beads or safety eyes (optional)
- Stitch marker
- Sewing pin
- Small amount of pink embroidery thread for embroider mouth.

### **Abbreviations:**

sc = single crochet (UK: dc double crochet)  
trc = Treble crochet

inc = increase (2sc in a stitch)  
dec = decrease (2sc off together)

hdc = half double crochet  
sl st = slip st (UK: sc single crochet)  
ch = chain  
rep = repeat(s)(ing)

dc = double crochet  
R = round

st(s) = stitch(es)

### **1. HEAD** Using light orange

- R1:** Make a loop with 6sc  
**R2:** inc6 (12sts)  
**R3:** \*sc1, inc1\* repeat 6 times (18sts)  
**R4:** \*sc2, inc1\* repeat 6 times (24sts)  
**R5:** \*sc3, inc1\* repeat 6 times (30sts)  
**R6:** \*sc4, inc1\* repeat 6 times (36sts)  
**R7:** \*sc5, inc1\* repeat 6 times (42sts)  
**R8-11:** sc42 (42sts)  
**R12:** \*sc5, dec1\* repeat 6 times (36sts)  
**R13:** \*sc4, dec1\* repeat 6 times (30sts)  
**R14:** \*sc3, dec1\* repeat 6 times (24sts)  
**R15:** \*sc2, dec1\* repeat 6 times (18sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

### **3. LEGS** Make 2 pieces /using pink and light orange

- start with pink**  
**R1:** Make a loop with 6sc  
**R2:** inc6 (12sts)  
**R3:** \*sc1, inc1\* repeat 6 times (18sts)  
**R4-5:** sc 18 (18sts)  
**R6:** **switch to light orange**, sc5, dec4, sc5 (14sts)  
**R7:** sc5, dec2, sc5 (12sts)  
**R8-14:** sc 12 (12sts)  
**R15:** \*sc4, dec1\*repeat 2 times (10sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

### **2. BODY** Using white, light orange and pink

- start with white**  
**R1:** Make a loop with 6sc  
**R2:** inc6 (12sts)  
**R3:** \*sc1, inc1\* repeat 6 times (18sts)  
**R4:** \*sc2, inc1\* repeat 6 times (24sts)  
**R5:** \*sc3, inc1\* repeat 6 times (30sts)  
**R6-7:** sc30 (30sts)  
**R8-11:** **switch to pink**, sc30 (30sts)  
**R12:** \*sc3, dec1\*repeat 6 times (24sts)  
**R13:** **switch to light orange**, \*sc2, dec1\*repeat 6 times (18sts)  
**R14:** sc18 (18sts)

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

### **4. COLLAR** using white

- R1:** ch35, turn  
**R2:** ch1, sc5, hdc3 dc2, dc2, hdc3, sc5

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

### **5. CROWN** Using bright yellow

- R1:** ch35  
**R2:** ch1, sc10, \*hdc1, dc2, ch3(work on last dc), dc1 hac1\* repeat 3 times,sc10

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

**6. ARMS** Make 2 pieces /using light pink and light orange

start with light orange

- R1: Make a loop with 6sc
- R2: \*sc1, inc1 \* repeat 3 times (9sts)
- R3: \*sc2, work 3-dc puff, sc6 (9sts)

**3-dc puff(3 dc to be a puff)**

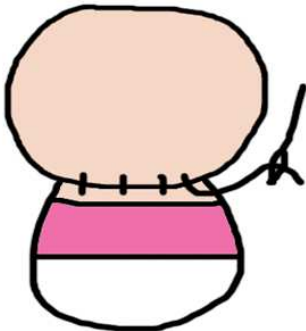


- R4: sc9 (9sts)
- R5-8: switch to light pink, sc9 (9sts)
- R9-11: sc9 (9sts)
- R12: sc1, dec1 \* repeat 3 times \* (6sts)

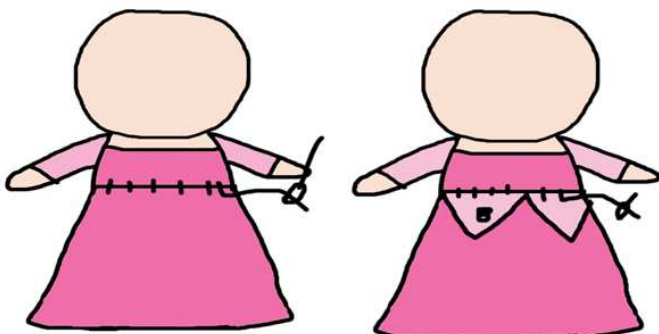
Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

**ASSEMBLY**

1. Stuff with polyester then sew head to body.



3. Sew skirt to body on R8 (count from bottom), sew B and A.



**7. SKIRT** Using soft blue and light blue

**A: Using pink**

- R1: ch30, join
- R2: ch1, \*sc4, inc1\*, \* repeat 6 time join (36sts)
- R3-5: ch1, sc36, join (36sts)
- R6-12: ch1, \*sc5, inc1\* repeat 6 time, join (42sts)
- R13: ch1, sc42, join (45sts)
- R14: ch1, \*sc2, inc1\* repeat 14 time, join (56sts)
- R15: ch1, sc56, join (56sts)
- R16: switch to light pink, work on back loop, ch1, sc56, join (56sts)
- R17: ch1, sc56, join (56sts)

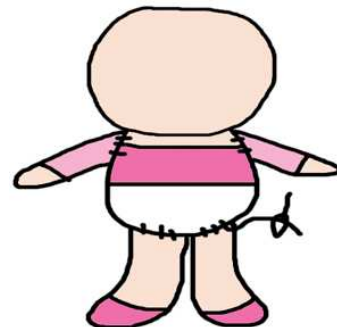
Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off.

**B: Make 5 pieces/ using light pink**

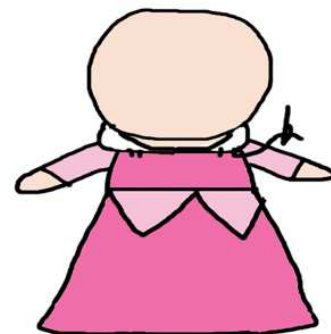
- R1: ch7
- R2: ch1, dec1, sc3, dec1, turn
- R3: ch1, dec1, sc2, dec1, turn
- R4: ch1, dec1, sc1, dec1, turn
- R5: ch1, 3sc off together

Slip stitch into the next stitch and fasten off leaving length for sewing.

2. Stuff with polyester then sew legs and arms to body.



4. Sew collar to body on R12.



5. Use yellow yarn to making hair by cut the yarn around 12inches long. Sew on center of head back to end of head. Brush her hair with comb till the hair fluff up.



6. Roll hair on front, sew beside and sew crown on head.



7. Sew 5mm black bead as an eye, embroidery pink thread as mouth, brush a small amount of pink or red blusher on cheeks.

**Safety Notice**

Buttons and small parts can be a hazard to small children. To be safe, all animals intended for use as toys should have embroidered eyes.
