## Activities and Definitions

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### Site Preparation and Development

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#### 1 - Demolition

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Demolition of works by manual or mechanical means (apart from explosives). This activity comprises, for connection to and protection of the existing work, accessory or supplementary works including:

- Masonry
- Sheet metal work, roofing and sealing
- Roads and utility services

#### 2 - Earthworks

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Undertaking, in the open air, digging and sheeting of provisional excavation in the ground, as well as the groundwater drainage works needed for undertaking the works, backfilling, unassociated rock filling and filling up except for quarries being the subject either to constitute a work themselves or to allow work to be undertaken. This activity includes investigations and drilling.

#### 3 - Soil Improvement

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Processing, reinforcement and soil improvement in-situ, in order to improve physical and mechanical properties. This activity comprises laying geotextiles (apart from geomembrane), investigations and boring.

#### 4 - Roads and Utility Services: Pipework - Sewerage and Drainage - Roadways - Pavements - Paving - Irrigation - Green Spaces

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Undertaking pipework, autonomous sewerage and drainage, buried networks, paths and carriageways, columns and enclosures. Work on green spaces, including supplementary masonry works.

#### 5 - Fitting Scaffolding - Shoring

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Fitting, for third parties, all fixed or suspended shorings or scaffoldings, or lifts used for the construction or maintenance of properties, monuments and buildings as well as fitting temporary structures.

#### 6 - Asbestos Processing

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Removal of asbestos, materials and products containing, as well as their elimination or their confinement, in the entire work or part of the work.

#### 7 - Curative Treatment (Xylophagous Insects - Mushrooms)

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Curative treatment of woods in the structure and the constructions for insects with xylophagous larvae, termites and mushrooms in the frameworks and joinery work made of wood, but also the ground, foundations, walls, partitions and floors.

#### 8 - Drying of Walls

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Treating walls for rising damp. This activity comprises preparatory works and treatment per se as well as accessory and supplementary works for the replacement of cladding.

## Structure and Carcass

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### 9 - Special Foundations

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Undertaking deep foundation systems such as piles, batten plates, moulded partitions, pile-planks, self-supporting partitions and any other equivalent techniques. This activity includes groundwater drainage work, investigations and boring.

### 10 - Reinforced Concrete Masonry Except Prestressed In Situ

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Undertaking reinforced concrete masonry, whether prefabricated or otherwise, in prefabricated, prestressed concrete (except prestressed in situ), in agglomerated block of mortar or cellular concrete, in natural stones or bricks, as much for infrastructure as the superstructure, by any masonry techniques of pouring, rough-casting (except lining of pinned, attached or adhered wall).

This activity includes the works of:

- Rendering on the base of hydraulic or synthetic binders
- Redressing in masonry
- Brickwork, paving
- Paving, screed
- Foundations other than piles, batten plates, moulded partitions, pile-planks, self-supporting partitions and any other equivalent techniques

As well as accessory or supplementary work of:

- Earthworks and buried pipework
- Additional sealing of buried walls
- Placing materials contributing to interior insulation
- Placing wood or metal reinforcements needed by opening the bays and taking them up into the groundwork
- Placing jambs
- Placing simple framework elements, including neither gain nor assembly and bedded directly to the masonry, and to the exclusion of any framework prefabricated in the industry
- Plastering
- Tiled flooring, faience and covering hard mineral-based materials
- Weather-stripping joints

The following work associated with boiler installation:

- Construction, repair and maintenance of hearths and fireplaces (except furnaces and industrial chimneys)
- Smoke and ventilation conduits for domestic and individual use
- Redressing and restoration of chimney stacks except attics
- Construction of chimneys for domestic and individual usage
- Coverings in floor tiles and faience panels

### 11 - Concrete Prestressed In Situ

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Implementation of prestressed, reinforced concrete put under tension on-site.

### 12 - Framework and Wooden Structure

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Creation of frameworks, structures and carcasses on a wooden base excluding curtain walls. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Roofing, cladding, various frameworks, when these are attached directly to the carcass
- Roofing or sealing supports
- Ceilings, false ceilings, partitions made of wood and other materials
- Floors and parquets
- Thermal and sound insulation attached to the carcass or the framework
- Preventative and curative treatment of woods
- Installing materials or any metallic elements forming the building, for reinforcement or for the stability of frameworks and staircases

### 13 - Framework and Metallic Structure

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Installation of frameworks, structures and metal carcasses excluding curtain walls. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Roofing, cladding, various frameworks, when these are metal and attached directly to the carcass
- Roofing or sealing supports
- Protection and treatment for corrosion
- Treatment for the fire stability by paintwork or flocking
- Work on the groundwork and by metallic structure
- Thermal and sound insulation attached to the carcass or the framework

## Building Stability

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### 14 - Roofing

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Undertaking, in all materials (except textile structures), including asphalt shingle, of roofing or wall panels. This activity includes the works of:

- Sheet metal work and PVC accessories
- Placing the roof framework, including vents in the roof, for solar sensors
- Undertaking insulation and screening under the roof
- Redressing and restoration of chimney stacks outside attics
- Installation of a lightning conductor

As well as accessory or supplementary work of:

- Sealed joints
- Installing vertical claddings

## Nomenclature for Insurers of Public Works

### 15 - Sealing the Roof, Flat Roof and Interior Floor

Undertaking the sealing of the roof, flat roof and interior floor by installing bituminous or synthetic materials on horizontal or inclined supports, including placing the sealing support.

This activity comprises, within any limits laid down in the procedure, the installation of insulating materials and includes all work for preparing the application, or for ensuring the protection of the sealed covering, as well as those required for completing the sealing of works.

As well as the undertaking of works including:

- Sealing the buried partition
- Sheet metal work and PVC accessories
- Roof framework (including vents in the roof)

### 16 - Sealing and Making Impermeable the Lining, Tanks and Swimming Pools

Sealing and making impermeable, under hydrostatic pressure, the linings of works including tanks and pools made of prestressed reinforced concrete. This activity also comprises the preparatory work, such as that for protecting and treating all the joints.

### 17 - Weather-stripping Protection, Impermeability and Seal of the Façades

Undertaking protection and renovation work on the façades using impermeable lining based on class I1, I2 and I3 polymers and sealing systems based on class I4 polymers. This activity includes the works of:

- Sealing the soil of the works, when it dominates the non-closed parts of the building
- Weather-stripping construction joints for the purpose of sealing from water and air
- Thermal insulation from the exterior

### 18 - Exterior Joinery Work

Undertaking exterior joinery work, including their protective covering, whatever the material used, with the exception of curtain walls. This activity includes the works of:

- Installing the filling elements, including resin or plastic products and polycarbonates
- Weather-stripping on site of joinery work joints
- Installing the enclosures and solar protections, whether or not integrated,
- Coverings and interior/exterior joints.

As well as accessory or supplementary work of:

- Glazing and mirrors
- Power supplies, controls and any electrical connections
- Installation of materials or products contributing to thermal, sound, fire and safety insulation
- Preventative and curative treatment of woods

## Nomenclature for Insurers of Public Works

### 19 - Wall Sheeting

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Installing the wall sheeting by techniques other than those of curtain walls by implementing clapboards or panels, with or without incorporation of insulating material. This activity includes panelling work.

As well as accessory or supplementary work of installing materials of products contributing to thermal insulation.

### 20 - Curtain Walls

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Realisation of curtain walls, whatever the material used, including installing infills and facades using the techniques of structural silicone glazing or fastened structural glazing

### 21 - Textile Structures and Roofing

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Creation of superstructures and roofing based on textile membranes that are either taut or expanded. This activity includes creation of supplementary structures on a base of wood, metal or other materials as well as all the elements needed for draining water.

## Divisions - Improvements

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### 22 - Interior Joinery Work

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Undertaking all work on interior joinery work, including protection covering of it, whatever the material used, for the doors, walls, ceilings, false ceilings, partition walls, floors including stilted, parquets including sports grounds, coverings, stairways and guard rails, stands, exhibitions, fairs, fixtures and fittings.

This activity includes the works of:

- Installing the filling elements, including resin or plastic products and polycarbonates
- Covering and interior and exterior joints

As well as accessory or supplementary work of:

- Glazing and mirrors
- Installation of materials or products contributing to thermal, sound and fire safety insulation
- Preventative and curative treatment of woods

### 23 - Plastering - Staff - Stucco - Ornamental Plasterwork

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Undertaking plastering, partitioning and false ceilings based on plaster. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Joinery work integrated into partitions
- Interior thermal sound lining
- Installation of materials or products contributing to thermal, sound and fire safety insulation

## Nomenclature for Insurers of Public Works

### 24 - Locks - Metalwork

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Installing the locks and metalwork including cables and sections in sheeting from all metals or synthetic materials. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Protection from corrosion risks
- Installation and connection of electrical power supplies and automated systems needed for the equipment to operate
- Installing infills, including resin or plastic products and polycarbonates,
- Installing the materials or products contributing to thermal, sound and fire safety insulation.

### 25 - Glazing - Mirrors

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Undertaking all work from glazing products, including resin or plastic products, polycarbonates excluding curtain walls. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works for the rigid frame of glazed elements.

### 26 - Paintwork

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Undertaking the paintwork, including high build or semi-build plastic covering, redressing the paintwork or by cleaning, placing flexible coverings, textiles, plastic or similar onto the horizontal and vertical surfaces. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Joinery work
- Faience coverings
- Cleaning, sanding, grit blasting
- Sound and thermal insulation by the interior and exterior

Making impermeable and sealing work is not included.

### 27 - Covering of Surfaces in Flexible Materials and Floating Floors

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Undertaking adhered or floating floors, flexible coverings, with or without textile base, in any plastic, rubber or similar materials, or in wood (veneer sheeting on Kraft paper or textiles, adhered veneers or adhered plywoods) or any other relevant to the same techniques of implementation.

### 28 - Covering Surfaces with Hard Materials - Screeds and Poured Grounds

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Undertaking the covering of surfaces in floor tiles and any other product made of hard materials, either natural or artificial (except lock seaming, ties), screeds and poured grounds. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Placing sound or insulation notch ductile under the screed or floating floors
- Sealing under non-submerged tiled flooring
- Protection by making the tiled flooring and faience bases impermeable

### 29 - Thermal Insulation - Sound - Refrigeration

Creation, including their coverings and joinery work, of:

- Thermal insulation of walls, partitions, grounds, ceilings and roofs of all works
- Insulation and sound treatment by installing adapted materials or substances
- Refrigerating insulation of premises of any capacity and operating at any temperature
- Lagging circuits, pipework and equipment.

### Technical Batches

### 30 - Plumbing - Sanitary Installations

Undertaking sanitary installations (production, distribution, drainage) and hot water installations (sanitary and heating), fluid or gas networks, except for geothermal technologies and placing integrated solar sensors.

This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Decking, creation of support and base for apparatus and equipment
- Screeds to protect heating installations
- Trenches, clearance holes, cross ditches and connections
- Lagging, thermal and sound insulation
- Electrical connection of the equipment.

### 31 - Thermal Installations of Climatic Engineering

Undertaking installations (production, distribution, drainage) of heating and refrigeration, including controlled mechanical ventilation, except geothermal technology and placing integrated solar sensors. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Decking, creation of support and base for apparatus and equipment
- Screeds to protect heating installations
- Trenches, clearance holes, cross ditches and connections
- Lagging, thermal and sound insulation
- Electrical connection of the equipment

### 32 - Boiler Installation

Installation (except for furnace and industrial chimney) of ventilations systems for the products of combustion. This activity includes the works of:

- Construction and installation of hearths and fireplaces
- Construction of boiler bases
- Placing on the ground refractory and ceramic tiles

As well as accessory or supplementary work of:

- Connections to various renderings
- Lagging of conduits
- Coverings in floor tiles and faience panels

### 33 - Ventilation and Air Conditioning Installations

Undertaking of installations (production, distribution, drainage) ensuring the functions of heating, renewal and treatment of air, refreshment, except for geothermal technology and placing integrated solar sensors. This activity comprises the accessory work needed for the installation and operation of these installations for:

- Decking, creation of support and base for apparatus and equipment
- Screeds to protect heating installations
- Trenches, clearance holes, cross ditches and connections
- Lagging, thermal and sound insulation
- Electrical connection of the equipment

### 34 - Electricity

Undertaking the electric current distribution networks, electrical heating, as well as the connection and installation of electrical appliances (except placing integrated solar sensors). This activity comprises the installation of controlled mechanical ventilation (CMV) and placing equipment for protection against the effects of lightning.

As well as accessory and supplementary work of:

- Trenches, clearance holes, cross ditches and connections,
- Screeds to protect heating installations.

### 35 - Furnace and Industrial Chimney

Undertaking the work of constructing industrial furnaces, incineration and cremation furnaces, including their chimneys.

### 36 - Lifts

Undertaking a lift, good lift, personnel lift, mechanical escalator and rolling walkway, including their operational devices and equipment need to operate them.

### 37 - Pools

Undertaking of pools including the operational devices and equipment needed to use them, except geothermal technology and placing solar sensors

## Nomenclature for Insurers of Public Works

### 38 - Wooden Framework House

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Undertaking of all the wooden components or wood-derived components. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Ceilings, false ceilings, partitions made of wood and other materials
- Interior and exterior joinery work
- Thermal and sound insulation
- Preventative and curative treatment of woods
- Treatment of the woods being used against xylophagous insects
- Installing materials or any metallic elements forming the building, for the reinforcement or for the stability of frameworks and staircases

### 39 - Geothermal Technology

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Undertaking heating installations and those for the refreshment and production of sanitary hot water by techniques using aerothermodynamic or geothermal energies, with any types of fluid. This activity comprises the accessory or supplementary works of:

- Investigation, boring and earthworks
- Decking, creation of support and base for apparatus and equipment
- Trenches, clearance holes, cross ditches and connections
- Lagging, thermal and sound insulation
- Electrical connection of the equipment
- Protection screed of the heating installation
- Installation of controlled mechanical ventilation
