It also fits Corolle Cheries!



This version is unlined and made in very thin fabric scavenged from an old child's raincoat. Raglan sleeves make it easy to use with slick, shiny fabric.

Neck/hood seam is topstitched down. It closes with a narrow (.25") overlap with hidden snaps.

You can make this in fabric with lining, but you should probably increase the size a little bit or wear it open to compensate for the lining.

Eliminate width at the front, shorten and make it in thin fleece or felt as a toggle coat like this:
