ACCESS

FROM ZAVENTEM AIRPORT

Leave the airport and take the BRUSSEL - RING direction
Go straight on and follow the RO-RING/EXPO/CARGO direction
Bear to the left and follow NAMEN/LUIK/LEUVEN - E40-E411
Keep following this direction and stay on the ring for about 10 kilometres
Leave the ring in Leonard crossroad and follow the E411 - LUXEMBOURG-NAMEN-BRUSSEL direction
Bear to the left to the E411-LUXEMBOURG/NAMEN direction
Drive for 50 km and at the Dausoulx highway interchange take the E42 in direction of LIEGE
Drive for 25 km and take the exit 7 - VINALMONT
Take the direction of VINALMONT
After 100 metres, take the 1st right to the direction of MOHA, HUCCORGNE
After 600 metres, bear to the left and drive for 2 kilometres along the motorway
Bear then to the right and pass below the motorway.
Follow the indications 'Training Week – AGROTOPIA'

FROM CHARLEROI AIRPORT

Leave the airport and take the second exit in the roundabout in direction of « Fournisseurs aéroport »
At the next roundabout, take the second exit in direction of E42/Heppignies
Follow the road and take the first exit E42 - MONS - LIEGE at the next roundabout and take the access road to the motorway by following Bruxelles/Mons/Liège/Namur
Bear to the left in direction of LIEGE/NAMUR
Drive 54 kilometres and then take Exit la Sortie 7 - VINALMONT
Take the direction VINALMONT
After 100 metres, take the 1st right to the direction of MOHA, HUCCORGNE
After 600 metres, bear to the left and drive for 2 kilometres along the motorway
Bear then to the right and pass below the motorway.
Follow the indications 'Training Week – AGROTOPIA'

FROM BRUXELLES-MIDI RAILWAY STATION

Take Huy direction. The train goes through Namur or Liège according to timetable. The journey takes about 1 hour 40 minutes.
